LICENSE REQUIREMENTS

An annual license is required to manufacture or distribute fertilizer in this state, except no license is required of persons distributing:

- 1. Fertilizer materials to a licensed manufacturer for further manufacturing;
- 2. Packaged fertilizer in the original container that is labeled, and permitted if required, by the licensed manufacturer or distributor;
- 3. Bulk fertilizer obtained for resale purposes from a licensed manufacturer or distributor, not mixed or blended except to combine identically labeled lots received from the same licensee, and properly invoiced using label information furnished by the licensee.

Distributors Only

If you are only distributing in Wisconsin and do not meet an exemption listed above (1, 2 or 3), only one fee for all Wisconsin sites is required.

Note: Licenses are non-transferable and fees are non-refundable. Additional manufacturing plants or mobile units may not begin operating during the license year without obtaining an additional license and payment of an additional fee, as outlined below.

MD	Manufacturer Dry Fertilizer	Manufacturer of fertilizer ingredients or producer of fertilizer in which each granule contains the same chemical analysis.
MI	Manufacturer Liquid Fertilizer	Manufacturing of ammoniated phosphates, including 10-34-0, in Wisconsin (includes "Anhydrous Converter".)
D	Distributor/Sales	Distribute or sell fertilizer with YOUR company label BUT manufactured by another company.
AA	Anhydrous Ammonia	Storage & distribution of anhydrous ammonia.
DD	Dry Blend	Blender of dry ingredients as part of business.
LB	Liquid Blend	Blender of liquid fertilizers, including dilution by lawn care firm.
LC	Lawn Care:	Lawn care firm or lawn care service, along with other fertilizer activities. (also see: Liquid Blend.)
NA	Nonagricultural	Labeler of fertilizers for nonagricultural uses such as lawn and garden, indoor plants, nursery, etc.
PI	Pesticide Impregnation	Pesticide impregnation of fertilizers, either liquid or dry, and either custom or packaged (weed & feed, etc).
0	Main Office	A premise that serves as the administrative center of the business. This location may be licensed solely because it is used as the guarantor of commercial fertilizer – it is identified as the responsible party on the label.
S	Branch	A premise located somewhere other than the firm's main office location and is still involved in the business activities of the firm.
W	Branch	A facility or premise in or at which the commercial fertilizer is stored.
